<p><u>ALL LEADERS</u> Youth Protection Training is required for all registered adults. Must be retaken at least every 2 years.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><u>CUB SCOUT LEADERS</u></p> <p>Specific training for every Cub Scouting role is offered.
