Policy Statement regarding:

Authorized Council/District Signatures for the Eagle Scout
Service Project Workbook and
Eagle Scout Service Project Fundraising Application

The Eagle Scout Service Project Workbook---Proposal section and the Eagle Scout Service Project Fundraising Application, both require an authorized Council/District Signature for approval.

The only Individual(s) authorized to sign on the Council/District's behalf in regard to an Eagle Scout Service Project Proposal and/or an Eagle Scout Service Project Fundraising Application is limited to:

1. The District Advancement Chairperson, (for the Scout's district)
2. A, currently Registered in Scouting, Adult; specifically chosen by the current District Advancement Chairperson for that District. This chosen substitute must be trained for this role and is knowledgeable about BSA policy as well as The Guide To Advancement.

Note: That although the District Advancement Chairperson authorizes this adult, in their district, to sign on behalf of the District/Council, the District Advancement Chairperson will still be direct responsibility for this decision, to the Council Advancement Committee.

In the event that the District does not have an actively serving District Advancement Chairperson or approved surrogate, Scouts, Unit and District Leaders seeking a Council/District signature for the Eagle Scout Service Project Proposal and/or an Eagle Scout Service Project Fundraising Application should contact the Council Advancement Chairperson, who in turn, will either approve/sign, or designate an authorized signatory.
